

## Friday, April 10th, Preschool Plan: Good Friday

This is a solemn service experience in our liturgical calendar, so take time to discuss with your child about the significance of this event as you feel is age-appropriate for your kid(s).

**Song:** Christ Died for our Sins

*Lyrics:*

*Christ died for our sins, according to the scriptures. Repeat*

*He was buried (echo) and he rose (echo)*

*again the third day according to the scriptures.*

*1 Corinthians 15:3-5*

**Story:**

Watch the video of the story being read out of the *Jesus Calling Storybook Bible* (page 214), read it straight from Scripture in Matthew 27 or read from another children's storybook Bible.

**Discussion Questions:**

1. What happened on Good Friday?
2. Why do we call this a "good" day?
3. Jesus cried out "It is finished." What was finished?
4. Can you recite this week's Bible verse, John 3:16?
5. How does this story make you feel?

**Communion Liturgy:**

-Parent holds the bread, tortilla or cracker and says:

*This is the body of Christ broken for you, we take it in remembrance of Him.*

-Parent breaks the bread and passes it out.

-Parent holds the cup of grape juice and says:

*This is the blood of Christ shed for the sins of all mankind, we take it in remembrance of what He has done.*

-Let kids dip their bread or cracker into the grape juice and then eat them.

-Pray together, *Amen!*
